Hope is the faith and trust that God is there, even when we can't see him or hear him. Hope is knowing that God is looking after us, even when we can't see a way out.

So today I pray Paul's prayer from Romans 5 over you:

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."
