
# St. Matt's Midweek Update - 7th March 2025





We are now a couple of days into Lent and I've been thinking about what people do to mark the season of Lent. Lent is a season of preparing for Easter, and focusing on growing closer to God and recognizing what Jesus did for us on the cross.

The traditional way to mark Lent is to give something up, as we remember and reflect on Jesus' 40 days of fasting and praying in the wilderness, and spend time ourselves preparing for Easter. Have you given anything up for Lent this year?

But more recently people have moved away from giving things up, or are more aware of not just giving something up for the sake of it, so some people try and take up a new habit, or set aside more time each day or each week to spend time with God and to read the Bible or pray. I am going to try and read through the gospel of Mark this Lent, as we've started looking at the book "Mark for Everyone" by Tom Wright in our pod.

Another popular idea in recent years has been the campaign by Stewardship to "Do Lent generously". The idea is that each day in Lent you do something generous for those around you, and Stewardship give ideas and challenges each day. Today's challenge is to be generous to one person local to you, with the idea that we can't solve all the problems around us, but we can help one person.

What could you do to show someone you care today?

We can all do Lent differently, but the important thing is that what we do keeps us focused on Jesus, and prepares us to do His ministry here on earth as we look towards Easter and ultimately to His second coming.
